Performance opportunity for young musicians aged 16-25

- Are you aged 16-25?
- Do you sing or play an instrument?
- Do you love music?

We are looking for young musicians to be part of a new production, *Lost in Music*.



What is *Lost in Music*?

Lost in Music is a new gig-theatre performance being created by composer Kim Moore and director/writer Nicholas Bone and produced by Magnetic North, a theatre company based in Edinburgh, in collaboration with Platform in Easterhouse.

Lost in Music has been built around interviews with young people about what music means to them. Live music performed by a multi-talented ensemble including Alex Neilson (Trembling Bells), Claire Willoughby, Emily Phillips and Jill O'Sullivan (Sparrow and the Workshop, bdy_parts) tells their stories, interwoven with the story of Orpheus and Eurydice.

What is the opportunity?

We are looking for up to 10 young musicians in Glasgow to be part of the performances of *Lost in Music* at Platform in Easterhouse on 6th and 7th March. The musicians will learn a new piece of music written by Kim Moore and will perform it alongside the professional cast as part of the performances. We are looking for instrumentalists (for example, guitarists, bassists, keyboard players) and singers.

Where does it take place?

Platform, 1000 Westerhouse Rd, Easterhouse, Glasgow G34 9JW

Will I get paid?

Yes! We will pay you for rehearsal and performance sessions at the National Minimum Wage for 21-24 year olds (£7.70/hour).

How much time will it involve?

You will need to commit to and attend 3 rehearsals before the performance week, all to be confirmed.

In the performance week, you would also need to commit to, and attend as follows:

- Monday 4 March – evening (rehearsal)
- Tuesday 5 March - evening (rehearsal)
- Wednesday 6 March – afternoon (dress rehearsal) and evening (performance)
- Thursday 7 March - evening (performance)
